Thoughts on Today's Readings

Today we celebrate the good news of Jesus' triumph over death with the conviction that what happened to Jesus will also happen to us. In Acts, Peter preaches the good news: Jesus, judge of the living and the dead, offers forgiveness. Jeremiah (ALT) foresees a time of restoration reminiscent of the first exodus. In today's psalm, the hearts of believers resound with shouts of victory: "The LORD has done a mighty thing!" Paul reminds us that Christ is now our life, and we have set our hearts on him. In the gospel, the tomb is empty, and the risen Jesus reassures Mary Magdalene of his victory.
